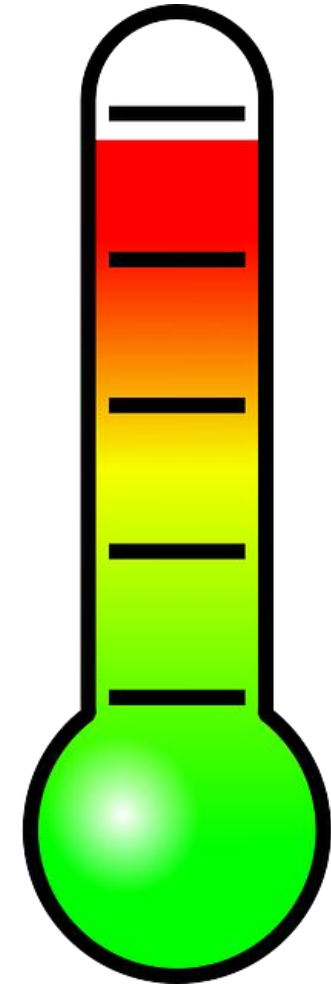

Key Agreement Requirements

- **Accessibility:** All deliverables need to be created in a machine-readable format compliant with the AODA
- **Open Licensing:** All content developed needs to be made public under a creative commons license.
- **Third-party materials:** Secure rights to embed third party content into the deliverable.
- **Funding acknowledgement:** All deliverables must provide prominent notices that the deliverables are funded by the Province of Ontario and Ontario Online Learning Consortium (OOLC).

Budget Planning

- Funds will be transferred quarterly to UofT, 25% of total per transfer:
 - April 15, 2021
 - July 15, 2021
 - October 15, 2021
 - January 15, 2022
- Budget Change Process: Changes need to be approved by eCO before:
 - New line items are created
 - Existing line items are removed
- Your local business officer will be your first point of contact for budgetary questions

Reporting Requirements

- Quarterly progress reports are required by eCO (format TBD by eCO):
 - June 18, 2021
 - September 17, 2021
 - December 16, 2021
 - February 28, 2022
- OVPIUE required by eCO to complete submission.
 - OVPIUE/OLS will not review submissions unless specific questions are noted.

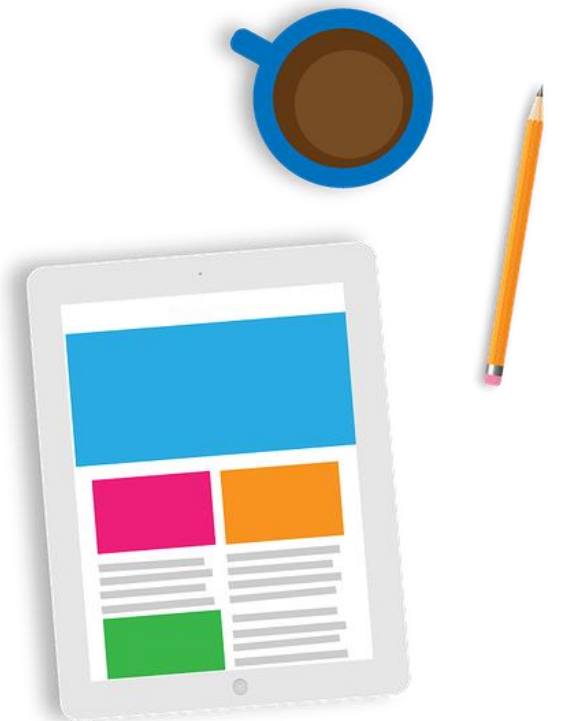

Building/Hiring Your Team

- **Outsource:** Upwork; Zip Recruiter
- **Buy out time of UofT staff:** cost recovery/transfer
 - *if* capacity available to work on VLS project
- **Hire casuals:** Use your professional network
 - Colleagues, grad students – iSchool, OISE, relevant discipline
- **RAs:** Follow practices within your division
 - (TAs – not an option unless direct relevance to current course delivery)
- **Post opportunity via Career Centre/Work Study for Fall term**
 - Student contributions or focus groups
